PIERS JACKSON STRUCTURAL HARMONY

Jackson returns to his old stamping-ground of Ladbroke Grove to install Structural Harmony at Morton's new space beneath Tom Dixon's water tower.

The private and elusive London-based artist is showing geometric reliefs in pastel shades from his most recent collection Introspection, along side work from his previous brightly coloured collection Silky's Dream.

Inspired by number and geometry, Piers Jackson uses pigment-dyed card and gold leaf with fascinating effect. His first ever floor sculpture The Ouroboros takes centre stage at Structural Harmony and proves that this well respected artist has more to say.









