## Luna Park

The title for this exhibition comes from seeing long-exposure photographs of fun-fair rides in Luna Park, Coney Island, New York. These images capture the abstracted motions and vivid spectrum of colours against the inky-black night skies that excited my visual senses.

I am not driven to paint representations of the real world. For me, my intuition is to explore the unseen, to respond intuitively to colour, mark making and form. At its root, there is a love for gestural abstraction, animation/cartoon and graffiti that plays itself out in the decisions I make. It's a desire to weave a common thread between these diverse ways of seeing that has been a constant theme to date.

Visual, painterly surface effects serve to create harmonies and discords in colour and form. These moments are what I search for. The correct amount of *rightness and wrongness* in equal measure.

So the Luna Park becomes a framework for a body of work I would describe as an exhalation of abstraction. I invite the viewer to ride the waves of paint, to immerse themselves in the layers and enjoy the transitions and spectacle of space.

## Simon Williams

Simon Williams trained originally in Fine Art painting at Loughborough College of Art and Nottingham University.

A highly inventive artist, Williams has maintained a parallel working life as an artist and designer in the film industry. He has worked with companies from Spitting Image to Jim Henson's Creature Shop and has created Animatronic creatures and effects on many high-profile films, from Harry Potter to Star Wars.

Williams has exhibited widely, in 2016 he curated an exhibition 'After Illusion' which brought together six prominent Abstract painters of the South West. In the same year, he was included in the prestigious John Moores painting prize held at the 'Walker Art Gallery' Liverpool. His most recent exhibitions have been a solo show 'Ultra Space' exhibited in Bristol in 2018 and 'New Vocabulary' at Serena Morton Gallery in London.

Williams lives and works in Cornwall; his current studio has a spectacular view of the Atlantic Ocean in the historic Porthmeor Studios in St Ives.






